Activity Professional Delivery Standardisation and Support days



Overview

Based on the feedback nationally from our network of over 1200 Activity Professionals, feedback from our RQM's (Regional Quality Managers) and national review we have decided to run a series of regional Activity Professional CPD events to support the standardisation for practical delivery and raise standards throughout next academic year.

Available to you every half term will be a regional face to face training and networking event for all Activity Professionals that will be topical, based on the time of year and critical standards we expect for 'delivery the Premier way'. Each event will be backed up with additional videos, articles and webinars that run each month so we are ensuring that every AP get the relevant CPD and support to continually improve.

These sessions will also act as a fantastic opportunity for Activity Professionals to network, exchange ideas at the same time as 'having fun and giving joy' with the practical competition element that will be bolted on the end of each event.

Dates & Bookings

Each session will run during half term in each of the 6 regions of the country and will be delivered by the RQM following a national consistent programme and plan that can be seen below – to book following the link to the TWP website and click on the relevant course.

Learning Focus

These will be the critical areas that will be covered on each session and all regional session will follow a consistent learner programme. See these below and the Tutor lesson overview.

Practical Focus

Based on AP feedback – almost 90% of replies commented that they really value the practical elements of the courses and also the opportunity to interact, compete and perform practical games activities – this again will be termly and topical and provide each of the AP's attending with hands on activity ideas at the same time as achieving CV's - 1,2,3,5 with the opportunity for potential regional competitions between AP's and the different workforce's teams within the country.

Brief Tutor Plan CPD day overview

This plan will fall in line with the planning framework and outstanding planning expectations e.g. **Introduction ideas –** clearly establishing the outcomes and why the AP's are here and what they will learn

Preparation Ideas – this will always be a practical activity of 5 tutor lead activity ideas linked to the overall theme e.g. if the session is linked to inclusion use of STEP the Tutor will purposely and subtly include this in the activities to prepare all AP's for the day ahead and immediately providing them with activity ideas.

Develop and Challenge ideas – This is the main content of the CPD session designed to provide each AP with critical support linked to the planned half termly topic – the tutor will make this inclusive and engaging for each individual AP – this will be split into two key areas of DEVELOP and CHALLENGE – DEVELOP will be for example introducing key knowledge and actual strategies to learn and understand – CHALLENGE will be to take the AP out of the comfort zone and think learn independently on what actions and things they now need to actually do to grow and enhance there standards.

Performance Ideas – APs will put together and practically demonstrate their learning combined with a AP competition on the designated activity area e.g. invasion games – this would at the same time provide all AP's with a solid understanding of competition expectations when working with children on any given topic.

Plenary – All AP's will recap in groups on learning and establish critical actions to take forward – these should be recorded on an electronic training feedback form that can be captured and shared.

Financials

So that we can make this appealing cost effective for areas regardless of size the following payment options will be made available:

Option 1 - £30 per person + VAT – this will be for the booking of just one individual per course

Option 2 - £150 + VAT to send MAX 10 AP's to just one AP CPD day **Option 3** - £650 for all 6 yearly modules to send as 10 AP's to each event (£125 per event) this must be per event and not 60 places for the year – e.g. if you have 5 on one event you cannot bank the 5 places you have missed. Franchisees can share these places if required.
