

Government Reschuffle – October 2013

Introduction

On Monday 7th October 2013, David Cameron carried out a ministerial reshuffle that included the promotion of four women as part of his pledge of making a third of all ministers to be female ministers by the next General Election in 2015.

Notable Conservative figures such as Ian Ducan Smith, Work and Pensions Secretary, or the Chancellor of the Exchequer George Osborne have unsurprisingly remained in their respective posts.

The Labour Front Bench also underwent some changes as Ed Miliband attempts to sharpen up the Labour's team before the 2015 general election. More women have also been appointed and "Blairite" Liam Byrne and Stephen Twigg have been dismissed, demonstrating according to some commentators, a shift to the left away from his party's Blairite past. Andy Burnham remains Shadow Health Secretary, which may indicate that Public Health will be a big debate in the General election.

This brief highlights the main changes, which occurred within the Department of Health, the Department for Education and the Department for Culture, Media and Sport as well as within the Shadow Cabinet.
